PROPOSED CHANGE TO CONSTITUTION – To Be Considered At The June Membership Meeting Change the constitution by adding a paragraph to Article 13 to maintain a member as "active" without payment or loss of seniority during active duty in the United States Armed Forces

Article 13 - Dues

Any Alton Motor Boat Club member in good standing who is called to active duty by a branch of the United States Armed Forces will retain their existing rights and seniority as a regular or social member through out their tour of active duty without paying coupon, membership, or work hour fees. At the conclusion of the member's active duty period the member will have two (2) months in which to notify the board and pays fees such as may be due for the remainder of the year from that point forward. This call to active duty assumes that the member will no longer be residing in the local area where regular access to the Alton Motor Boat Club would be available. (For example a Scott Air Force Base or St. Louis recruiting office assignment would not be considered out of the area.) Other fees such as for a dock rental or a parking spot would not be waived.
