#### PROPOSED CHANGE TO CONSTITUTION – To Be Considered At Future Membership Meeting

Article 10- Membership of the Alton Motor Boat. The purpose of this proposed change is to make a prospective member eligible for membership without a two month, or longer, wait while allowing all members an opportunity to be aware of the applications on file.

#### Article 10 – additional paragraph between paragraph 4 and 5.

In lieu of a "1<sup>st</sup>" reading at a regular membership meeting, a prospective membership application may be read at one board meeting and posted in a prominent location on the Club bulletin board for a minimum of two weeks. Both must be satisfied prior to the "2<sup>nd</sup>" reading and consideration of the application by the membership at a regular meeting. It is not necessary for the application to be read at a board meeting prior to the beginning of the two week posting.
