You can help prevent the possibility by making sure your children wear their life jackets at all times while they are on the docks and in the boats. If you see someone else's children on the docks without their life jackets, remind them. It could make a difference some day. If you don't like the rule, don't ignore it, come to the membership meeting and see if you can get it changed.
