FROM THE COMMODORE

At our April membership meeting, the regular members present voted, on what was then our only bid, to hire Stutz Excavation Company to "Long Stick" our harbor. Due to numerous Corp of Engineers requirements, the starting of the job was delayed.

At our May 20th membership meeting, Clay Halford, who has been instrumental to the entire harbor maintenance process, presented an option for dredging the harbor for less than previous dredging bids. The bid was voted on an accepted by the present membership. Groh Dredging & Marine Construction agree to dredge the entire harbor and pump the sediment removed into long tubes that will allow the water to drain on site. The dredging labor, insurance, tubes for sediment and fuel will all be included in the Groh bid. Dock movement and sediment haul off are not included. Our membership approved additional funds that can be used if and when needed for haul off and other accidentals.

As always, all members are urged to attend meetings when possible. Membership meetings allow the regular member to voice their opinion and cast their vote on important club issues. The more input we have, the better the discussion will be.

Harbor revenue, more than anything else, allows us to flourish and spend money on club improvements and repairs. Filling our empty slips and retaining our current renters is vital to our club's prosperity.
