At our membership meeting, Butch Rister provided an update of the Piasa Creek environmental study:

A recent meeting by the Corps of Engineers was held to update everyone on their study for the solution to silting in of Piasa Chute. Attending this meeting were local representatives Alley Ringhausen from the Great Rivers Land Trust at Piasa Harbor, John Generis of the Migratory Waterfowl Hunters and Butch Rister of the Alton Motorboat Club.

Results of this study included a combination of dredging and building dikes to correct this problem. A project start date for this construction is 2018. In addition, it was learned that maintenance of the public ramp in Piasa Creek has been assumed by the Corps of Engineers. By next year, they hope it will be usable again.
