DOCK REPAIR (MATT KNIGHT 618-407-9890)

Dock repairs from the April storm are complete. Butch Rister accompanied a representative from the Corps of Engineers recently as he conducted an audit of our harbor. The Club was cited for many things. The dock owner is responsible any dock extensions (where dock boxes are located) if you have one. If your dock extension is rotted, or damaged in any way, you, the dock owner is solely responsible for its repair. Open flame grills are not permitted on the docks. Extension cords from the outlet into vessels are not permitted. All walkways must be clear of lawn chairs, paddles, coolers, or other miscellaneous items. Let's keep our docks clean and safe!

These trailers will be given free parking for the remainder of the year, then will be invoiced for their spot for the 2018 season. Parking at the Boat Club is very affordable at a rate of \$100 per spot. Also, our insurance company is requiring each member who uses the harbor or ramp to produce certificates of insurance. This will be mandatory with the February membership renewal.
