FROM THE COMMODORE

The following is from Shane Simmons - UMRR Project Manager, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, St. Louis District and is summarized.

- Good news! The Final Feasibility Report for the Piasa and Eagle's Nests Islands Habitat Rehabilitation and Enhancement Project has been approved by the USACE Mississippi Valley Division Commander. This is a direct result of the collaborative effort put forth and the tremendous support for the project. Thanks to everyone involved! Now that the report is approved, we'll plan to move forward with development of detailed plans and specifications suitable for contract solicitation and award. We will be in close coordination with the US Fish and Wildlife Service and Illinois Department of Natural Resources. One of the first next steps is to collect updated bathymetric surveys of the project area. This data will feed directly into the project detailed design. We anticipate our survey crews will collect the updated bathymetry this fall.

We'll keep everyone up to date as we make progress and move closer to executing the project. –

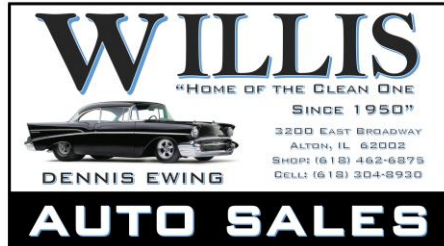
