#### The Overall Goal

Our goal is to open the club in some form, whether this means a portable building, making the pavilion a temporary clubhouse, or being able to use the existing clubhouse until repairs are completed. Frankly, we just will not know until the water recedes and we speak with the FEMA Coordinator.

This committee is currently working on issues of repairing the club and alternate plans for building a facility above the floodplain. If we build above the floodplain this could save the club over \$9,500 per year in flood insurance and other expenses with battling the flood waters. We are working on preliminary cost of repair vs building a facility above the floodplain. The Long-Range Committee hopes to have some information to share at the June membership meeting.
