PAST EVENTS

17 December – Membership Meeting at Lockhaven

A crowd approaching 100 filled the Lockhaven Ballroom as the membership listened to a proposal to demolish our existing clubhouse, and use insurance funds and a low interest loan to construct a brand new elevated Boat Club. A roll call vote of all regular and honorary members was administered to document this huge moment. The results were 61 yes votes, 0 no votes. The loan will be paid for by funds formally allocated for expensive FEMA flood insurance.

UPCOMING 2020 ELECTION DETAILS

Our annual election will be held on January 21st at Lockhaven. This year, 5 of our 9 board positions are up for grabs. Chairpersons Jenkins, Holmes, Fill, Knight, and Ontis will have fulfilled their commitments and may step down or campaign for another 2 years.
