For this year's Poker Run, we have appointed two AMBC Board Members to serve as Event Safety Officials. These officials will be in the best position to serve as points of contact to resolve any safety concerns during the Poker Run. This year's Safety Officials are Vice Commodore Mark Gibbs and Dock Repair Chairperson Red Dunham.

#### HOUSE: (Dan Fitzgerald - 618.806.3708)

Insulation and a window air conditioning unit have been installed in the smoke shack to keep our volunteer workers a little more comfortable. The window A/C unit came from the old clubhouse and was retrofitted for use in the smoke shack.

Siding, soffit, and gutters on the existing pavilions have been scheduled to be repaired.

#### **DOCK ASSIGNMENT**: (Suzie Fill – 618.781.4558)

Our harbor has only 2 open slips available and they are going quick. Each of these slips have been available longer than 15 days and are now open to the first taker. You can have your boat ready when you are, and in the water for as little as \$88 per month.

The slips that are available immediately are a 36-foot slip, #1, and one 38-foot slip, #40. One 32' slip, #45, has just been posted for bid.

If you have a trailer in the assigned parking area, please keep the area around your trailer clear of any trash and please trim any weeds around your assigned parking.

#### **GROUNDS**: (John Dooley – 618.830.8755)

We need to turn some of our attention to the club grounds. If you need work hours, we have some tasks that need to be completed. Staining of the wood swing sets need to be completed ASAP. Please contact Grounds Chairperson Dooley if you would like to help in one or more of these areas.

Several complaints have been brought before the Board concerning the use of off-road, two and four-wheeled vehicles on Club property. Due to liability and safety concerns, the use of any off-road vehicle on Club grounds is strictly prohibited.

Since dues became payable in February, only 18 members have formally resigned. Due to the pandemic, we have been under a "pay as soon as you can" policy. Our hope was to retain every possible member. However, the time has come when we need to collect the dues from any unpaid member by August 31<sup>st</sup>. Any dues received on or before the 31<sup>st</sup>, that member will remain in good standing retaining their seniority. If the dues are not received by August 31, 2020, you will need to go through the application process to re-join the ranks and you will lose your current seniority.

Our plumber will soon be roughing in, and the 3 steel posts and I-beams will go up quick. Yes, we are getting a new Clubhouse, but we are really getting two new Clubs. Think dining and drinks upstairs, meanwhile hosting another event in our 3,400 square foot "basement." Maybe a cornhole tourney, Wii Bowling, maybe BINGO.... It is your Club and your options are endless.

Since the very day that the State of Illinois allowed us to gather, we have again been hosting Queen of Hearts Thursdays. It has been a great return to our Boat Club Family. Queen of Hearts has been a great revenue source for the Boat Club since we began on 2/9/17. We have held 161 total drawings and sold 91,156 tickets!! If you know the rules, you know that the Boat Club take is 40% or \$36,462. Thanks to everyone who plays. I only wish we would have started this game sooner.

We have a lot to be positive about. After months of sorting through government red-tape, complicated by COVID keeping people away from their offices, we finally obtained all the permits. 
