-Jul 17 – First Blocks of our new "Basement" are set

- -Jul 27 Block basement structure completed
- -Aug 17 Floor trusses set into place
- -Aug 18 First upstairs wall is raised into place
- -Aug 21 Work begins on our awesome deck
- -Aug 31 Roof Trusses set
- -Sep 2 Plywood installed on roof
- -Sep 3 Stairs contruction begins
- -Sep 7 Shingles layed
- -Sep 12 Handrail construction begins
- -Sep 22 Siding Begins
- -Oct 4 HVAC ductwork installation begins
- -Oct 6 Interior walls framed
- -Oct 8 Windows installed
- -Oct 13 Plumbing begins
- -Oct 14 Electrical work begins
- -Oct 14 Air Conditioner lifted into place.
- -Oct 19 Gutters installed
